Overview

The Faculty of Health Sciences (FHS) of the University of Nairobi (UoN) is the leading tertiary healthcare training center in Kenya and the East & Central Africa region. It was created in 1985 and has its origin in the Faculty of Medicine which was established in 1967.

The Solution

This partnership will focus on building capacity at FHS in four phases, namely:







- **Phase 1.** A world class, globally accredited diagnostic services center, provide teaching, clinical testing to support affordable patient care and research facilities therein;
- **Phase 2.** To utilize existing capacity at the faculty to establish a Sports Medicine Research and Testing Laboratory to test for the presence of performance enhancing substances and commonly abused substances among athletes, World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) accredited Laboratory;
- **Phase 3.** A high-performance athletic training center with world-class equipment, expert coaching staff and dedicated programs exclusively for athlete development. This will run in conjunction with Sports Medicine and Scientific Services as well as hospitality; and
- **Phase 4.** A Comprehensive Cancer Diagnostic Center with a focus on nuclear medicine and high-resolution Radiology/Imaging suites.
